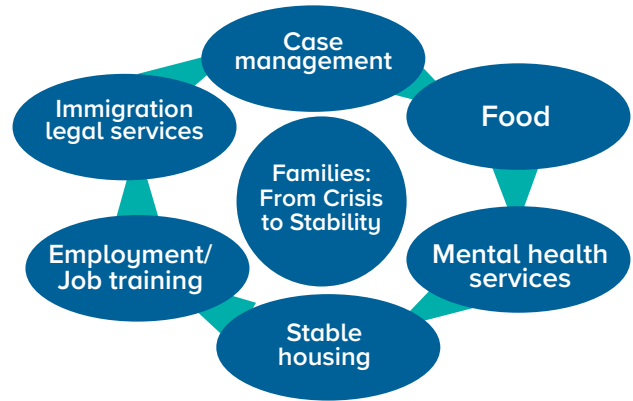


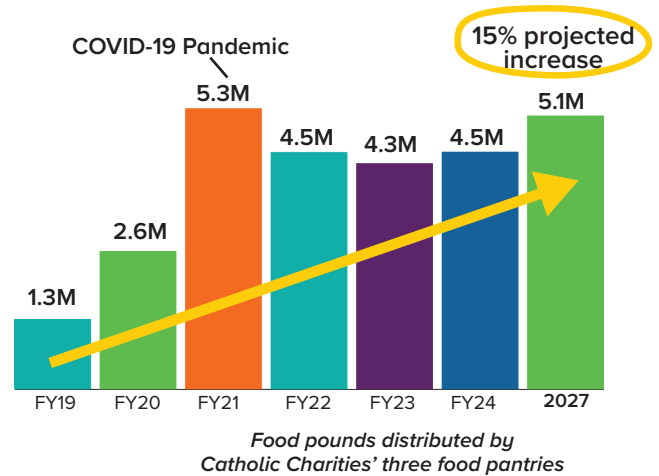

A New Center Will Allow Us to Prevent Hunger for More Families

Higher grocery prices threaten more families with hunger. As the need for food assistance continues to grow, our ability to serve hungry families will increase with a new facility. The Center will feature a larger self-select food pantry and ample space outside for increased drive-through food distribution.



One million people or 14% of families are food insecure (at risk of hunger) in the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston

Increased Space = Increased Services for Families in Need

The Family Opportunity Center will be constructed in one of the poorest neighborhoods in the Houston area. At this new location, Catholic Charities can help many more individuals get food, shelter, and the tools and guidance needed to live with self-sufficiency and dignity.



Disaster Recovery When disaster strikes, we will be able to increase distribution of financial aid, as well as food and other essentials, to help families in need recover from losses they experience from storms and other natural disasters.
