A New Center Will Allow Us to Prevent Hunger for More Families

Higher grocery prices threaten more families with hunger. As the need for food assistance continues to grow, our ability to serve hungry families will increase with a new facility. The Center will feature a larger self-select food pantry and ample space outside for increased drive-through food distribution.
