If You Had to Choose Between Paying Your Bills and Staying in School, What Would You Do?

You helped Aaron and his family when medical bills forced them to make this choice

Aaron is a smart, motivated teenager. But a medical emergency put his family in a tough financial situation and nearly forced him to drop out of high school.

When Aaron became seriously ill, his family took him to a local clinic. Although he recovered quickly, his family was left with more than \$10,000 in medical bills they could not pay. Anxious and stressed about his family's financial situation, Aaron made plans to drop out to help support his family.

Not wanting a bright student like Aaron to leave school, his high school counselor contacted Catholic Charities' Guadalupe Family Assistance Program for help.

Thanks to you, Catholic Charities was there for Aaron and his family. The staff at the Guadalupe Center helped them apply for emergency financial assistance. Because of your support, Catholic Charities paid the initial installment of a payment plan that worked with the family's limited budget.

Because of you, now Aaron doesn't have to choose between finishing high school and helping support his family.

Dozens Answer Call to Help Children and Families Separated at Border



Thanks to the service of dozens of volunteers, Catholic Charities' Cabrini Center was able to provide legal assistance to this vulnerable group of immigrant children.

With the help of 72 volunteer attorneys from local law firms and other practices, the St. Frances Cabrini Center for Immigrant Legal Assistance provided access to legal help to 87 unaccompanied children in Catholic Charities' care.

More than a dozen of the cases that qualified for pro bono direct representation were placed with attorneys. A few cases remain on a waiting list and Cabrini continues to steadily place these cases with pro bono attorneys.

Thank you to the Houston legal community who stepped up to the plate to offer your time, your talents and your skills to help this particularly vulnerable group of immigrant children. We are grateful for your compassion and service to launch these legal workshops which serve the children and families in need.

Your Support Keeps Families Fed and Secure at Home



With your help, Catholic Charities' Guadalupe Center feeds thousands of families each year through our food pantry and fairs. The center is also home to the Villa Guadalupe, which provides short-term housing and services for women veterans and their children.

Elena and her family live on the financial edge. A single mom, Elena has a low-paying part-time job, and she's able to leave her pre-school age children with a neighbor. But an unexpected car repair would create a financial crisis that could put Elena's family on the street.

Because you support Catholic Charities, families like Elena's can get the help they need. The Guadalupe Family Assistance program provides resources that keep a roof overhead and food on the table during the hardest of times.

Your support also enables the Lewis and Joan Lowenstein Foundation Pan De Vida Food Pantry to offer nutritious groceries to promote good health, including a variety of perishable and nonperishable food items. In addition, hundreds of families visit our food fairs each month, taking home bags of fresh vegetables and fruit, bread and meat. Guadalupe Center is one of the few food pantries that welcomes anyone, regardless of their zip code.

So that families like Elena's stay in their homes and keep the lights burning, your support allows the program to provide funds for rent, utilities and other emergency expenses.

Clients can meet with a case manager who can discuss what else the family needs and help them find resources that sustain low income families when money is running low, such as SNAP (formerly food stamps).

With your help, Guadalupe Family Assistance restores hope to thousands of others like Elena through food, clothing and financial assistance for vulnerable low-income families until they return to self-sufficiency.
