Decent, safe and affordable housing is a pillar supporting economic self-sufficiency and a greater sense of well-being for families and individuals.



# That foundation is weakened because we do not have enough affordable housing to meet the need.

#### THE PROBLEM:

The U.S. has a shortage of more than **7.2 MILLION** rental homes affordable and available to extremely low income renter households.




In Texas, there are only
29 affordable and available
rental homes
for every 100
extremely low-income
renter households.

# Households in the City of Houston

	Income level
16.5%	0-30% of median (127,120)
49.1%	0-80% of median (377,920)
22.5%	Pay >50% income for rent (92,435)
7.1%	Overcrowded (54,770) (75% severely overcrowded)





# **Higher housing costs =**

Less \$ for food clothing healthcare transportation childcare savings





# Do you know someone who lives on a limited income and feels squeezed by housing costs?

- A grandmother who relies primarily on Social Security
- A neighbor who is receiving disability income
- A friend who is unemployed or under-employed
- Someone in a lower-paying occupation

   (i.e., pre-school teacher, classroom aide, retail sales, clerical support, caregivers, grocery clerks, maintenance workers, hair cutters, manicurists, and entry level public employees)

### **Stable Homes Program**

#### **Homeless Prevention**

Imminent risk of homelessness due to sudden reduction of income

#### **HOPWA**

Living with HIV/AIDS and at risk of homelessness

#### **Emergency Rent Assistance**

One-time assistance for low-income families



# Women Veterans Program

#### Villa Emergency Shelter

Women veterans and their children experiencing homelessness

#### Permanent Supportive Housing

Chronic homelessness with a diagnosed disability

#### Pathways to Hope

Women veterans experiencing homelessness or at risk

#### **CJD Crime Victims**

Basic needs, emotional and legal support for crime victims

## Rapid Re-Housing Program

Experiencing homelessness and very low income \*Must be referred through CoC Coordinated Assessment

Assistance securing housing for eligible clients
