









The Mamie George Community Center is a hub for Catholic Charities' services in Fort Bend County. The center provides food, clothing, shelter and a network of support services to people from all walks of life and religious backgrounds, with an emphasis on seniors.

PROGRAMS & SERVICES

FAMILY ASSISTANCE

Assists individuals and families with food, rent, utilities, medication, financial assistance and support as they work toward self-sufficiency. MGCC serves as the Houston Food Bank hub for Fort Bend County, and hosts monthly food fairs for low-income families.

TRINI'S CORNER MARKET

A self-select food pantry within the center. The market is available to Fort Bend County residents over the age of 60 in need of food assistance. A wide variety of fresh produce, meats, breads, canned goods, dry goods are available.

DRIVE THRU FOOD ASSISTANCE:

Our food pantry services include a weekly drive thru distribution available to all in need of food assistance. A variety of fresh produce, meats, bakery items, pantry staples and dairy items are available. Distribution times are Tuesday from 5-7PM or Thursday from 9AM-12PM. You are welcome to attend once a week as needed.

WOMEN VETERAN SERVICES

Catholic Charities Women Veteran Services offers hope for women who have served this country and are in crisis. We help through financial assistance for rent, mortgage, food, employment and education guidance, and through other services.



GRANDPARENTS RAISING GRANDCHILDREN

Many grandparents take an active role in raising their grandchildren. Our program provides information and support for grandparents through weekly meetings.

SENIOR WELLNESS PROGRAMS & SERVICES
