Marie was looking forward to a change. She and her three children moved to the Houston suburbs and she had a job lined up. But, as soon as she got here, the company announced layoffs, and Marie was not spared.

With no income, she didn't know how she'd be able to keep her family in their new apartment.

That's where you come into the story.

Because of you, Marie received rental assistance until she was able to find a new job as a part-time bus driver. You gave Marie breathing room, so her family didn't end up homeless.

Marie is a single mother and lived in Louisiana her whole life. A recent uptick in crime led to the family moving closer to the children's father in the Houston area. Losing the job was hard enough, but the moving costs made money even tighter.
